ICS 300 – Intermediate ICS

This course builds on the ICS principles presented in both the ICS 100 and 200 programs, and focuses on ICS principles for expanding and complex incidents. Topics covered include:

- Unified Command
- Incident/event assessment
- Establishing incident objectives
- Planning process
- Development of an Incident Action Plan (IAP)
- Incident resource management
- Demobilization
- Transfer of command and closeout

Target audience includes supervisory personnel who may be tasked with handling expanding and/or complex emergency incidents.
